Acts 2:3-4 (NLT)

- A Fiery CONVICTION.

...With the help of lawless Gentiles, you nailed him [Jesus] to a cross and killed him... Peter's words pierced their hearts, and they said to him and to the other apostles, "Brothers, what should we do?"

Acts 2:23, 37 (NLT)

- An Unstoppable JUBILATION.

That day about three thousand took him at his word, were baptized and were signed up.

Acts 2: 41 (Message)

They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and sincere hearts, all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people.

Acts 2:46-47 (NLT)

- A Glowing CONNECTION.

They all met together and were constantly united in prayer...

Acts 1:14 (NLT)

All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer... And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had.
